Bike – Ariel, rigid frame without pillion 1935-50

This bike uses a 'W' luggage rack

This fitting kit can carry a rack/topbox and panniers

Included in the fitting kit:-

Part Number	Quantity	DESCRIP
FA1530Q	6	Nyloc nut, M8, stainless
P501	2	Straight Leg 13" centres - extra middle hole
P522	2	Elbow shaped support arm
FA1507Q	6	Set bolt, M8 x 18, stainless
FA1029Q	6	Washer, half penny, M8, stainless

This is a simple kit to fit. Firstly remove the front spacers from the saddle lug which Ariel fitted when the bike did not carry a rack.

Note: all arms should fasten on the inside the luggage rack

Loosely attach the elbow-shaped arm first as shown in figure 1, using the bolts, nuts and washers supplied. Then mount the straight arm, the bottom fastening uses the existing rear mudguard bridge bolt (Ariel part number 0604).

Once the rack is in position, tighten all fastenings, keeping the rack level
